The All-On-Four procedure allows for the replacement of all the patient's missing or failing teeth in a single appointment. The All-On-Four procedure is the *most cost effective, definitive, gold standard option* for these patients.

Every practice has patients who are dental cripples, have terminal dentition, and are in constant pain. They can't taste their food or they can't enjoy the foods they want. They are tired of seeing the dentist for another extraction, another root canal, or another re-cementing of a crown. These patients feel socially awkward. - Full arch restoration with as few as four implants
- The provisional is fixed to the implants so the patient will have immediate function the day of surgery and never need a denture
- The final restoration is supported with a titanium bar and will restore the patient to 90% function

- Predictable, repeatable, minimally invasive
- Patients almost never need to undergo the pain and healing time associated with bone graft and sinus grafting procedures

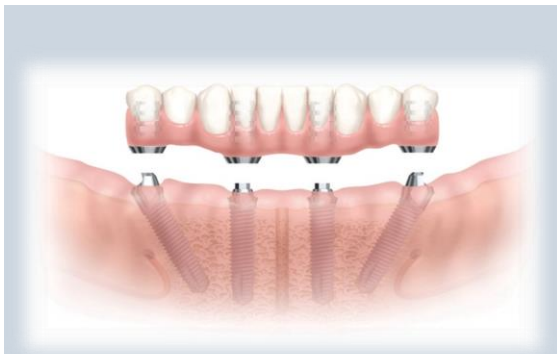
